

Our mission is to help solve the biggest global development challenges by investing patient, flexible capital to support private-sector growth and innovation. We currently partner with almost 1,500 businesses in emerging economies and have total assets of £8.1 billion.

Our aim is to create more productive, sustainable and inclusive economies in Africa, Asia and the Caribbean, enabling people to build better lives for themselves and their communities. We invest for impact but also to make a financial return. Those profits are then reinvested to support more businesses, in more places, to make a positive impact. 

We think innovatively about ways to deploy our capital, attract and mobilise other investors, and drive transformational impact. We have three strategic impact objectives – to invest in productive, sustainable and inclusive development.

We've developed a world-class framework for impact management, which is based on international standards.

To complement this, we've also developed an 'Impact Score' as a tool to manage strategic impact on a portfolio basis.

We are a key partner to the emerging economies that are most vulnerable to the climate emergency. Over the next five years, at least 30 per cent of our total new commitments will be in climate finance, making us one of the world's largest such investors in Africa.



Entrepreneurial investment

Our Investment teams support businesses to grow, so they can have a positive impact on people and planet, as well as be commercially successful. They work closely with Impact teams to ensure that we maximise value in our investments.

We invest across a broad range of capital products, using multiple channels. That includes investing directly into companies, banks and projects, as well as investing through intermediaries.

Our Investment teams focus on investing in priority sectors, and these sector teams are divided into product-focused sub-teams for equity, debt and funds. Our investments range in size, from smaller venture capital investments in early-stage companies, to large investments in infrastructure projects. We are a patient investor, with long-term investment horizons.









Application form

The form includes basic questions, i.e., personal details, education history, etc. Submit your application to ensure that you don't miss out on being considered for the programme.



Online assessment and video interview

The assessment will follow a situational judgement format and assess financial literacy. The video interview will assess your motivations for applying to BII and our graduate programme.



In-person Assessment Centre

Assessment centres are held at our offices in Victoria. London. The day will include three exercises: a group exercise, a case study and an interview (not necessarily in this order). The day is designed to assess both your technical skills/knowledge, as well as your motivations for applying to BII.
